## CHAP. IX.

AN ACT to Repeal part of and Amend the Law now in force assigning Limits to Gaols in this Province.

[Passed 17th Feb'y. 1827.]

Preamble.

W HFREAS it is desirable to extend the Limits assigned to the Gaol in the district of Niagara beyond those at present allowed by Law.

Be it therefore enacted, by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Upper Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of, and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act, passed in the Fourteenth Year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, 'An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec. in North America, and to make further provision for the Government of the said Province," and by the authority of the same, That so much of an Act passed in the Second Year of His Majesty's Reign, entitled, "An Act for assigning Limits to the respective Gaols within this Province, as enacts that from and after the passing of the said Act it shall and may be lawful for His Majesty's Justices of the Peace, in Quarter Sessions as-sembled, from time to time, in each and every District within this Province, to order, determine, and appoint, certain Limits of ground, not exceeding Six Acres, to each and every Gaol within the said Province," be, and the same is hereby Repealed, so far as respects the District of Niagara.

2 Geo. 4 Chap. 6 repealed, so far as it restrains the Limits to six acres in the District of Niagara.
