Punishment of persons forging Debentures, &c. IV. And be it enacted, That if any person or persons shall forge or counterfeit any Debenture to be issued under the authority of this Act, or any Stamp, indorsement or writing thereon or therein, or shall demand to have such counterfeit Debenture, or any Debenture with such counterfeit writing or other indorsement thereon or therein, to be exchanged for money by any person or persons who shall be obliged or required to exchange the same, or by any other person or persons whomsoever, knowing the Debenture so tendered or the indorsement or writing thereon or therein to be so forged or counterfeited, with intent to defraud Her Majesty, Her Heirs and Successors, or the person appointed to pay the same or any of them, or any other person or persons, body or bodies politic or corporate, then every person so offending being thereof lawfully convicted, shall be adjudged guilty of felony, and shall suffer such punishment as shall be adjudged in that behalf, not exceeding imprisonment at hard labour in the Provincial Penitentiary for seven years.

Debentures may be called in and paid off at any time. V. And be it enacted, That it shall and may be lawful for the Governor of this Province at any time by Proclamation to call in any of the said Debentures, although the time therein named for the payment thereof may not have arrived, in order that the same may be paid off, and that at the expiration of six months from the date of such Proclamation, all interest on the Debentures called in for payment as aforesaid shall cease.

Interretation clause.

VIII. And be it enacted, That the words "Governor in Council" whenever they occur in this Act, shall be construed to mean the Governor, Lieutenant-Governor, or person administering the Government of this Province, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof.
