48 George III – Chapter 8

An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the forty-sixth year of his Majesty's, reign, entitled "an Act to continue an Act passed in the forty third year of his Majesty's reign, entitled "an Act for the better securing to his Majesty, his heirs and successors, the due collection and receipt of certain Duties therein mentioned. Passed 16th March, 1808.

Whereas by an Act passed in the forty-sixth year of his Majesty's reign, entitled "an act to continue an act passed in the forty-third year of his Majesty's reign, entitled "an act for the better securing to his Majesty, his Heirs and Successors, the due collection and receipt of certain duties therein mentioned," it was thereby enacted that the said act of the Parliament of this Province, passed in the forty-third year of his Majesty's reign, should be and the same was thereby continued, and it was thereby further enacted that the said act passed in the forty-sixth year of his Majesty's reign, should be and continue in force for and during the term of two years, and from thence to the end of the then next session of parliament, and no longer; And whereas it is thought fit that the said recited act, passed in the forty-third year of his Majesty's reign, should not be subject to any limitations in point of time, but that the same should be made perpetual; Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by & with the advice & consent of the legislative council & assembly of the Province of Upper Canada, constituted & assembled by virtue of & under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intitled, "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of his Majesty's reign, intituled, "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act called in the fourteenth year of his Majesty's reign, intituled, "An Act for making more effectual provision for the government of the Province of Quebec, in North America, and to make further provision for the governemt of the said Province," and by the authority of the same, That so much of the act passed in the forty-sixth year of his Majesty's reign as limits the continuance of the aforesaid act to the term of two years, and from thence to the end of the then next session of parliament, shall be and the same is hereby repealed.
