53 George III – Chapter 7

An Act to repeal an act passed in the forty-fourth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act for granting to His Majesty a certain sum of Money for the further encouragement of the growth and cultivation of Hemp within this Province, and the exportation thereof," as also an Act passed in the fifty-second year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "an Act for granting to His Majesty a certain Sum of Money further to encourage the growth and cultivation of Hemp in this, Province, and for other purposes." Passed the 13th March, 1813.

Whereas the several Acts now in force in this Province granting to His Majesty a certain Sum of Money for the encouragement of the growth and cultivation of Hemp are not found beneficial in proportion to the expence incurred by them: Be is therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Upper Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, "An Act to repeal certain parts an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec in North America, and to make further provision for the Government of the said Province: and by the authority of the same, That an Act passed in the forty fourth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act for granting to His Majesty a certain Sum of Money for the further encouragement of the growth and cultivation of Hemp within this Province, and the exportation thereof," and also an Act passed in the fifty second year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "an act for granting to His Majesty a certain sum of money further to encourage the growth and cultivation of Hemp in this Province, and for other purposes," shall after the first day of September next ensuing the passing of this act; be repealed.
