55 George III – Chapter 8

An Act to provide for the rebuilding and repair certain Gaols and Court Houses in this Province. Passed the 14th March, 1815.

Whereas it is considered expedient to rebuild the Gaols and Court House in the District of Niagara, and in the Western District which were destroyed by the enemy; as also to build a Gaol and Court House in the London District and to repair the Gaol and Court House in the District of Newcastle: May it please your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted by the Kings Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of their Province of Upper Canada constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, "an act to repeal certain parts of an act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's reign intituled, "an act to make more effectual Provision, for the government of the Province of Quebec, in North America, and to make further provision for the government of the said Province and by the authority of the same, that out of the rates and duties already raised, levied and collected, or hereafter to be raised, levied and collected, there be granted to his Majesty, his heirs and successors, the sum of six thousand five hundred pounds, to be issued out of the funds now remaining or hereafter, to come into the Receiver General's hands, unappropriated, and arising from such rates and duties as last aforesaid; which said sum of six thousand five hundred pounds shall be disposed of, appropriated and applied in building Gaols in the Niagara, London and Western District; and repairing the gaol in the District of Newcastle, in the manner following, that is to say:—

For building a Gaol and Court House, in the Western District, two thousand pounds.

For building a Gaol and Court House in the District of London, two thousand pounds.

For building Gaol and Court House in the District of Niagara, two thousand pounds.

For repairing the, Gaol and Court House in the District of Newcastle, five hundred pounds.

II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the money hereby granted to His Majesty shall he paid by the Receiver General, to the treasurer of each of the said districts respectively in discharge of such warrant or warrants as shall for the purpose herein set forth, be issued by the Governor, Lieutenant Governor or person administering the government of this Province, and the Receiver General shall account to His Majesty, his heirs and successors for the same, through the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's treasury, in such manner and form as His Majesty, his heirs and successors shall be graciously pleased to direct.
