

Laws of His Majesty's Province of Upper Canada, passed in the year 1816. York: R. C. Horne, 1816.

56 George III – Chapter 1

An Act to alter the time of holding the Courts of General Quarter Sessions of the Peace, in the London and Johnstown Districts of this Province. Passed 22d March, 1816.

Whereas the Provisions of an Act of the Parliament of this Province, passed in the Forty-first Year of His Majesty's Reign, entitled, "*An Act to remove doubts with respect to the Authority under which the Courts of General Quarter Sessions of the Peace and other Courts, have been erected and holden; And other matters relating to the administration of Justice, done in the several Districts of this Province; And also to fix the times of holding the Courts of General Quarter Sessions of the Peace in and for the same,*" have not been found generally beneficial; Be it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Upper Canada, constituted and assembled, by virtue of, and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, entitled "*An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, entitled 'An Act for making more effectual Provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec in North America, and to make further Provision for the Government of the said Province,'*" and by the authority of the same, That so much of the second clause, of the said Act, as enacts that the said Court of General Quarter Sessions of the Peace, for the District of London shall be holden, on the second Tuesday in the months of March, June, September and December, and for the District of Johnstown on the third Tuesday in the months of February and May and on the second Tuesday in the months of July and October, be, and the same is hereby repealed.

II. And be it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That the said Courts of General Quarter Sessions of the Peace, shall be holden in the said London, and Johnstown Districts, at the places specially designated, by Law for that purpose at the following periods,—viz. on the second Tuesday, in the months of January, April, July and October, Provided always, and that this Act, shall not take effect until the first day of July next.
