6 William IV – Chapter 37 (Session 2)

An Act granting to His Majesty a sum of Money, for the improvement of Roads and Bridges in the several Districts of this Province. Royal Assent given by Message to the Legislature, 28th November, 1836.

Grants Fifty Thousand Pounds for the above purpose, to be divided as follows:
