2 Victoria – Chapter 49

An Act granting a sum of money to complete the construction of a Macadamized Road, from the Village of Dundas to the Township of Waterloo, in the Gore District. Passed 11th May, 1839.

Whereas by an Act passed in the seventh year of His late Majesty's reign, chapter seventynine, entitled, "An Act to authorise the construction of a Macadamized Road, from Dundas to Waterloo, in the Gore District," the Receiver General of this Province was authorised to advance, by way of loan, to certain Trustees therein named, the sum of twenty-five thousand pounds, for the purpose of Macadamizing the road leading from the Desjardin's Canal, in the Village of Dundas, to the Township of Waterloo, in the District of Gore; and also a branch of the said road where the Galt road intersects it, crossing the bridge at Galt, to the Township line of Waterloo: And whereas by the report of the Engineers employed, it appears that the said sum of twenty-five thousand pounds is insufficient to complete the said road, in the substantial manner contemplated: And whereas it appears that the said road has been commenced at various points or sections, which cannot be completed or united without, a further grant: Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council, and Assembly of the Province of Upper Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and tinder the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, entitled, "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's reign, entitled, 'An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec, in North America, and to make further provision -for the Government of the said Province," and by the authority of the same, That it shall and may be lawful for the said Receiver General, by and with the advice and consent of the Lieutenant Governor in Council, so soon after the passing of this Act as the same can be procured, to raise by way of loan, and advance to the same Trustees, the further sum of Eight Thousand Pounds, to be applied to the purposes of the Act above-mentioned, and no other.

II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That all and every the provisions of the before-mentioned Act, entitled, "An Act to authorise the construction of a Macadamized Road, from Dundas to Waterloo, in the Gore District," respecting the payment of the money so to be advanced to the said Trustees, the payment of the interest, the securities to be given, the re-payment of the principal, and every other matter and thing therein contained, shall apply to and be in force with respect to this Act.
