20 Victoria – Chapter 111

An Act to authorize the Municipalities of the Townships of East Zorra, West Zorra, and East Nissouri, in the County of Oxford, to dispose of certain Road allowances in the said Townships. Assented to 10th June, 1857.

Whereas the Municipal Councils of the Townships of East Zorra, West Zorra, and East Nissouri, in the County of Oxford, have respectively, by their petitions to the Legislature, represented, that the original allowance for Road between lots numbers thirty-five and thirty-six, in the several Concessions of the said Townships respectively, is not required, and have prayed that they may be empowered to dispose of the said allowance for Road, which prayer it is expedient to grant: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

I. The allowance for Road between lots numbers thirty-five and thirty-six, in the several Concessions in each of the Townships above named, is hereby vested in the Municipality in which such Road allowance is situate; and the Municipal Council of each of the said Townships respectively may pass a By-law or By-laws for the sale or disposal of the Road allowance vested in the Municipality thereof, or any part thereof, in like manner as they might for the sale and disposal of any real property acquired by and vested in the said Municipality, when no longer required for the use thereof; and the proceeds of such sale or sales shall form part of the general funds of the said Townships respectively.

II. This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.
