20 Victoria – Chapter 138

An Act to legalise the proceedings of the County Council of Kamouraska and the Local Council of St. Paschal. Assented to 10th June, 1857.

Whereas doubts exist as to the validity of the proceedings of the County Council of Kamouraska and the Local Council of St. Paschal existing in virtue of the Municipal and Road Act of 1855, in consequence of the appointment by the Secretary of the said Councils, of a Deputy to replace him in his said capacity during his unavoidable absence, under the tide of Deputy Secretary-Treasurer, or of Secretary-Treasurer pro tempore, inasmuch as, in consequence of the said appointment, the minutes of the proceedings of the said Councils, and the documents resulting therefrom, have been signed and countersigned by the Deputy Secretary-Treasurer and not by the Secretary-Treasurer; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

- I. The minutes of the proceedings of the said County Council of Kamouraska and of the said Local Council of St. Paschal, and the documents resulting therefrom, shall be and remain legal and valid to all intents and purposes, in like manner as if the said minutes and the said documents had been signed and countersigned by the Secretary-Treasurer himself.
- II. This Act shall be deemed to be a Public Act.
