20 Victoria – Chapter 183

**An Act to amend the Act incorporating the Literary Institute of Sherbrooke. Assented to 27th May,
1857.**

Whereas the Literary Institute of Sherbrooke hath prayed that the name of the said Institute be
changed, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

I. The Corporation established by the Act of the eighteenth year of Her Majesty's Reign, chapter
238, under the name of the Literary Institute of Sherbrooke, shall hereafter be known by the name of
the *College of Sherbrooke*, and under that name shall enjoy all the powers, privileges and advantages
heretofore enjoyed by the said Corporation under its former name, to all intents as if the name hereby
given to it were the designation originally assigned to it in the Act hereby amended.

II. This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.
