20 Victoria – Chapter 210

An Act to vest in John Shaw a certain allowance for road in the Township of Wilberforce. Assented to 10th June, 1857.

Whereas the Municipal Council of the united Townships of Wilberforce, Grattan and Frazer, have by their petition prayed, that the allowance for road between lots numbers five and six, in the sixteenth and seventeenth Concessions of the Township of Wilberforce, may be vested in John Shaw, of the said Township, in lieu of an allowance for road given to the said Municipality, running parallel to the said side line through the property of the said John Shaw; And whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

- I. The allowance for road between lots numbers five and six, in the sixteenth and seventeenth Concessions of the Township of Wilberforce is hereby vested in the said John Shaw, his heirs and assigns for ever.
- This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.
