20 Victoria – Chapter 213

**An Act to vest a certain Road Allowance in the Township of Brantford, in George S. Wilkes. Assented
to 10th June, 1857.**

Whereas George Samuel Wilkes, of the Town of Brantford, has prayed that a certain Road Allowance
upon his property in the Township of Brantford, known as Holmedale, be granted to him in lieu of
other roads laid out and opened by him thereon: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and
consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

I. So much of the original allowance for road between the western limit of the Smith and Kerby
tract, and the lands granted by the Crown to the late John Charles Digby, as lies south of Chestnut
Street, shall be and the same is hereby vested in the said George Samuel Wilkes, his heirs and assigns
for ever.

II. This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.
