20 Victoria – Chapter 52

**An Act to legalize the Articles of Notarial Students who have neglected to have them enregistered  
within the delay prescribed by law. Assented to 10th June, 1857.**

Whereas it is expedient to legalize the Articles of Notarial Students executed in Notarial form, and  
which have not been registered within the delay prescribed by law: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and  
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

- I. The Articles of Notarial Students, executed in Notarial form, the registry of which was not made  
according to law, shall be considered to have been duly registered, if the said Articles are hereafter  
registered in conformity with the next section; Provided always, that the word "Articles" in this Act,  
shall include transfers of the Articles of Notarial Students, made in Notarial form.
- II. If the registry of the said Articles has not already taken place, the said registry shall be made within  
one year from the passing of this Act.
- III. This Act shall apply to Lower Canada only.
