

## CAP. XIV.

## An Act to Repeal certain Ordinances therein mentioned relative to the Establishment of a System of Police in Canada East.

[12th October, 1842.]

**W**HEREAS it is expedient that the Ordinances and parts of Ordinances hereinafter mentioned be repealed from and after the day also hereinafter mentioned; Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, and intituled *An Act to Re-unite the Provinces of Upper and Lower Canada, and for the Government of Canada*, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that the Ordinance of the Governor and Special Council of the late Province of Lower Canada, passed in the Second year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled *An Ordinance to extend the provisions of the Ordinance for establishing an efficient System of Police in the Cities of Quebec and Montreal*, and the Ordinance of the Governor and Special Council of the said late Province, passed in the Session held in the third and fourth years of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled *An Ordinance to extend the provisions of the Ordinance for establishing an efficient System of Police in the Cities of Quebec and Montreal, to the District of St. Francis, in this Province*, and the Ordinance of the Governor and Special Council of the said late Province, passed in the session last aforesaid, and intituled *An Ordinance to repeal certain parts of an Ordinance therein mentioned, and to amend certain other parts of the said Ordinance, and to amend certain parts of another Ordinance therein mentioned, and make further provision for establishing and maintaining an efficient System of Police in the Cities of Quebec and Montreal, and the Town and Borough of Three Rivers*, shall be and the said Ordinances are hereby repealed from and after the first day of January, in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty-three: Provided always that the repeal of the Ordinance last above mentioned shall not affect the permanence of the Ordinance of the Governor and Special Council of the said late Province, passed in the second year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled *An Ordinance for establishing an efficient System of Police in the Cities of Quebec and Montreal*, which shall remain in force as it stood before the passing of the Ordinances hereby repealed, until it be repealed or altered by Act of the Legislature of this Province.
