CAP. V.

An Act to amend the Act for regulating the Shipping of Seamen, and to fund the fees payable under the said Act.

[23d March, 1848.]

THEREAS it is expedient to amend the Act passed in the Session held in the Preamble. tenth and eleventh years of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, An Act for Act 10 and 11 regulating the Shipping of Seamen, and to fund the fees payable under the said Act: Vict. c. 25, cited. Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, and intituled, An Act to re-unite the Provinces of Upper and Lower Canada, and for the Government of Canada, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the fees payable under the said Act and received by the Shipping Master, shall Fees received by the Shipbe funded, and the same shall be accounted for by him in the same manner and form ping Master, as other public monies are accounted for within this Province; and that after retaining to be funded and accounted a sum not exceeding two hundred and fifty pounds, currency, for each and every year's for by him. service, by way of salary and in lieu of all emoluments of office whatsoever, the said His salary not Shipping Master shall pay into the hands of the Receiver General, the net balance currency. received as such fees, after deducting necessary expenses and disbursements, such Balance to be balance to be applied to the public uses of the Province.
