## CAP. I.

An Act to repeal the Act of one thousand eight hundred and fifty-six, intituled, An Act to extend the provisions of the Insolvent Debtors' Act of Upper Canada, and for the relief of a certain class of persons therein mentioned.

[Assented to 31st March, 1857.]

HEREAS it has been found that the Act passed in the Preamble. Session of one thousand eight hundred and fifty-six, chapter ninety-three, and intituled, An Act to extend the pro- 19,20 V.c. 93. visions of the Insolvent Debtors' Act of Upper Canada, and for the relief of a certain class of persons therein mentioned, has operated prejudicially to the Mercantile interests of the Province, it is therefore expedient to repeal the same: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:
