4 & 5 Victoria – Chapter 70

An Act to extend and define the limits of the Town of Woodstock in the District of Brock. 27th August, 1841.

Whereas it is expedient to extend and define the limits of the Town of Woodstock, in the District of Brock; Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of, and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, intituled *An Act to Re-unite the Provinces of Upper and Lower Canada, and for the Government of Canada*; and it is hereby enacted by authority of the same, that all that tract of land lying and being situate within the boundaries hereinafter mentioned, shall from and after the passing of this Act, be within the Town of Woodstock, that is to say: a line commencing at a post planted at the South East angle of lot number nineteen in the first Concession of the Township of Blandford, and drawn thence in a Northerly direction along the East line of the said lot number nineteen to the allowance for road between the first and second Concessions in the said Township; thence Westerly along the outside of the said allowance for road, to the River Thames; thence along the water's edge on the Eastern side of the said River Thames to its junction with the Cedar Creek; thence along the water's edge on the Northern side of the said Cedar Creek to the Western line of the Township of East Oxford; thence Southerly along the said Western line of the Township of East Oxford to the allowance for road between the first and second Concessions of the said Township of East Oxford; thence Easterly along the centre of the said allowance for road, to the South East angle of lot number nineteen in the first Concession of the said Township of East Oxford; thence Northerly along the said line to Dundas Street; thence Easterly along Dundas Street to the place of beginning; and all allowance for roads adjoining the said boundaries shall be included within the same and the said town of Woodstock.
