9 Victoria – Chapter 16

An Act to increase the Salary of the Supervisor of Cullers. 18th May, 1846.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Act passed in the last session of the present Parliament, and intituled, An Act to regulate the Culling and Measurement of Timber, Masts, Spars, Deals, Slams and other articles of a like nature, and to repeal a certain Act therein mentioned, in so far as the said Act relates to the salary of the Supervisor of Cullers appointed under the authority of the said Act: Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, intituled, An Act to re-unite the Provinces of Upper and Lower Canada, and for the Government of Canada, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That so much of the twenty-first section of the said Act as limits the sum to be received and taken by the Supervisor of Cullers, as his annual salary, out of the funds coming into his hands, to four hundred pounds, currency, shall be repealed, and that such repeal shall be deemed to have effect from and after the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and forty-six, and that, reckoning from and after the said day, it shall be lawful for the said Supervisor of Cullers to take out of the said funds the sum of five hundred pounds, currency, annually, as his salary, exclusive of all the expenses of his office.
