18 Victoria – Chapter 152

**An Act to determine the manner in which the division or side lines of the Lots in the Township of Wolfe Island shall be drawn. Assented to 19th May, 1855.**

Whereas it appears by the Petition of the Inhabitants and Municipality of the Township of Wolfe Island, in the County of Frontenac, that serious evils would result to the proprietors of the lands in the said Township, if the division or side lines of the lots were drawn parallel to the governing boundaries, as provided by the thirty-seventh section of the Act of the Legislature, of this Province, passed in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, *An Act to repeat certain Acts therein mentioned, and to make better provision respecting the admission of Land Surveyors and the Survey of lands in this Province*; And whereas the said Inhabitants and Municipality have expressed their desire that the division or side lines of the lots in the said Township be drawn from the posts at one front of the concession to the posts bearing the same numbers at the other front thereof, without regard to the course of the base line of the Township, and it is expedient to grant their prayer: Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, and intituled, *An Act to re-unite the Provinces of Upper and Lower Canada, and for the Government of Canada*, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, as follows:

- I. For and notwithstanding any thing to the contrary in the thirty-fifth, thirty-seventh and thirty-ninth sections of the Act cited in the preamble to this Act, all the division or side lines of the lots in the said Township shall be drawn from the posts at one front of the concession to the posts bearing the same numbers at the other front thereof.
- II. This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.
