20 Victoria – Chapter 26

An Act to amend the Act incorporating the Stratford and Huron Railway Company. Assented to 16th May, 1856.

Whereas the Stratford and Lake Huron Railway Company incorporated by the Act passed in the eighteenth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and chaptered one hundred and eighty-four, have by their petition prayed that the periods limited for the first election of Directors and for the completion of the Railway may be extended, and it is expedient to grant their prayer: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

- I. For and notwithstanding any thing in the sixth section or in any other part of the said Act, the first General Meeting of the Stockholders of the said Company for the election of Directors, may be held at any time before the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight, and the Directors elected thereat shall remain in office until the first Wednesday in June, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight, or until the next Annual General Meeting of the Stockholders for the election of Directors after the said first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight; and the period limited by the fourteenth section of the said Act is hereby extended, so that the said Railway may be commenced at any time within two years, and completed at any time within seven years from the passing of this Act.
- II. This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.
